Thank you from MCC

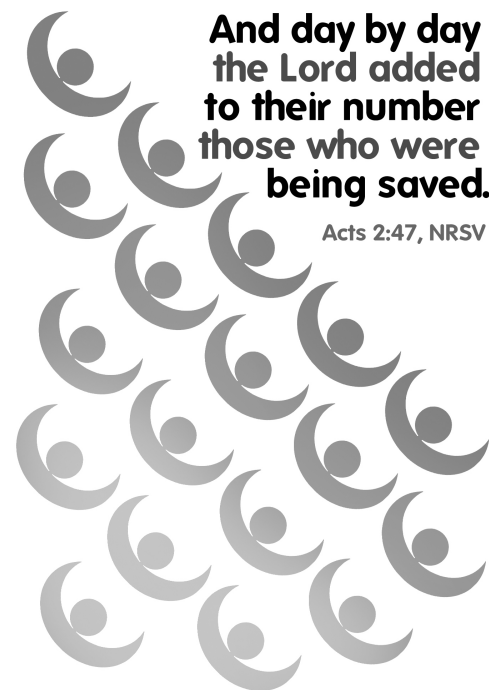
