RYLM Families and Shore Church families will connect with each other and with the community as they unite forces to do service projects.


What a great way to teach our children about service, get to know our Day Care families and spread the love of God to our community!

Isaiah 60:21 (NLT) says, "All your people will be righteous. They will possess their land forever, for I will plant them there with my own hands in order to bring myself glory."
