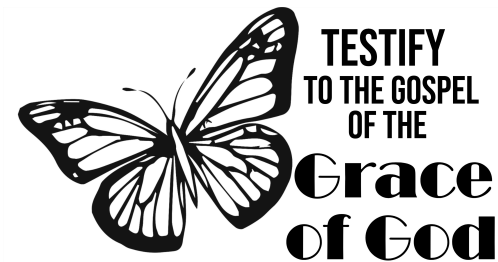
Hymn Sing - Marion Christian Fellowship invites you to a hymn sing tonight, October 30 at 6 p.m. Finger foods and fellowship will follow.

their Christmas Bureau November 28 - December 15. The Christmas Bureau is a special event hosted at the center with longer hours and more items available for families in need, to have access to winter items and Christmas presents for their children. It takes 25-30 volunteers to run the Bureau each day, and they need help feeding them.

If you have a smart phone or a tablet you can now access the directory app where you can get all the info on your church family right at your fingertips. The app is safe and secure because you have your own unique identifier code.

The only people that have the ability to see the information on the app are the same ones that have been given a hard copy of the directory that was in your mailbox. No one from the outside can get into the app because it is an app and not shareable and because you must have a code unique to you to access it.

The good thing about the app is that when new folks attend church, who aren't in the hard copy - the church office has the ability to add them.

From the app you have the capability to:

- Watch Sermons
- Email the church right from the app
- Call the church right form the app
- Access the calendar
- Access online giving through secure tithe.ly.com
- Access the directory from which you can call, email or get driving directions to anyone in the church (as long as they have an email address etc.)
- And you can also access the YouVerson Bible

If you have an email address your unique identifier code was emailed to you. Kim is happy to help you set up your app if you come visit her in the office. You will need your Apple ID to install the app and you will need your unique identifier code that was emailed to you.

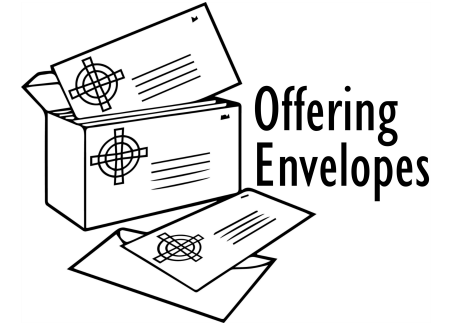


With space being tight here at the church during the remodel, it's especially important to check with the church office before you schedule meetings or events at the church.
