Even though the Sewing ladies are not able to use the Fellowship Hall during construction,

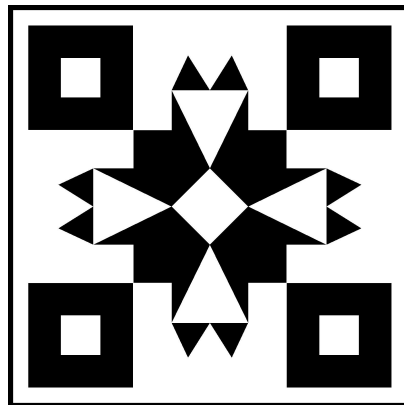
they remain busy bees! Last fall they were given the gift of yards and bins of beautiful fabric and they have put it to good use!
