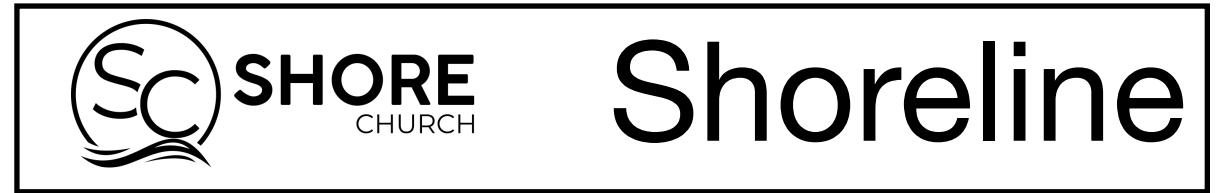

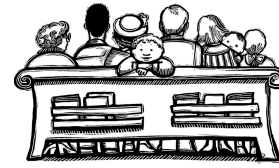
Kim is currently working on a new phone/address/email directory. If you have any changes to your contact
