FROM MCC RELIEF SALE

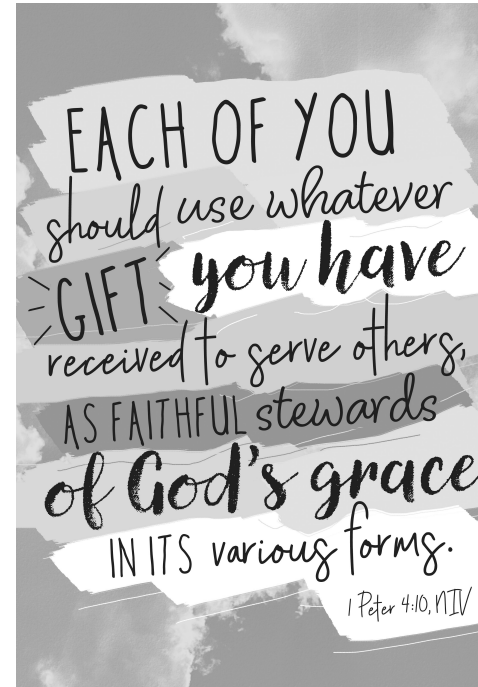
