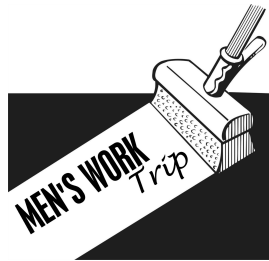

Gifts for Residents



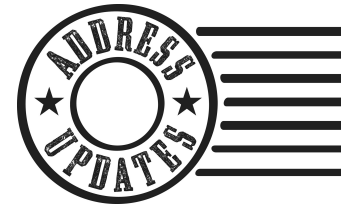
