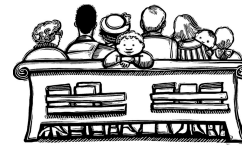


Christmas Caroling

**A note about FlockNote**

**A**s you know, the church uses an online messaging system called Flocknote to send out mass emails & texts to the congregation. It's a wonderful service that allows the administrator to get urgent prayer requests, announcements, and messages to you easily and quickly. Flocknote is an app that is attached to the church email, meaning all replies go to the church office only via email. Therefore, if you reply to a Flocknote message after office hours or on a Saturday or Sunday, it may not be seen until the next time Kim is in the office.
