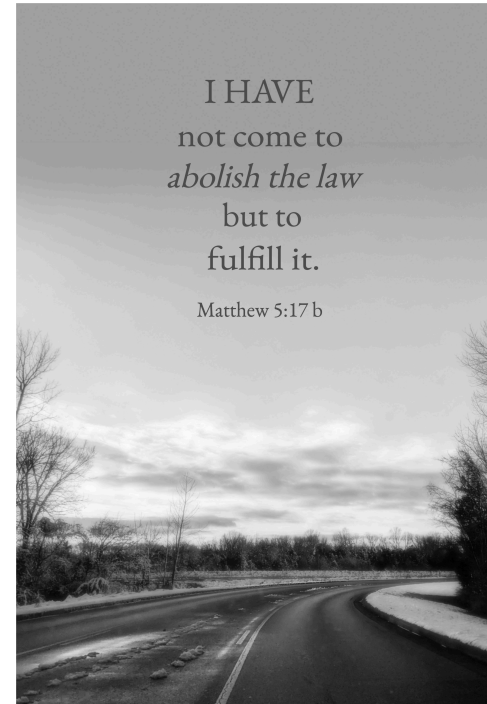

Gardening help needed!

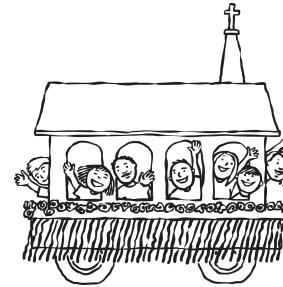

Who's New in the Pew?

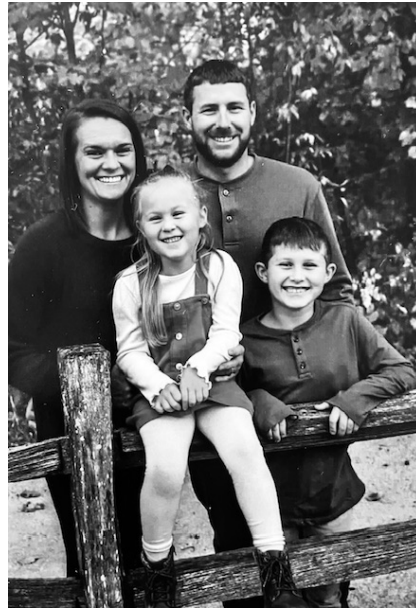
Ryan & Shantel Hochstetler

The Hochstetler's love being outdoors. Ryan is an avid hunter and fisherman and has introduced both sports to Gatlin, who also enjoys them.

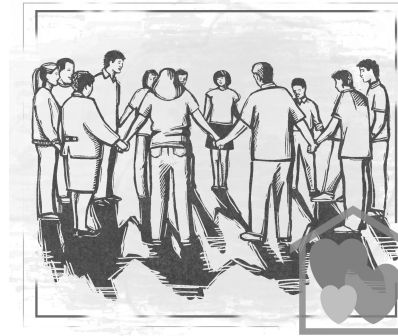
They are a busy family who is on the go from spring to fall with both kids playing soccer and Gatlin playing baseball.
