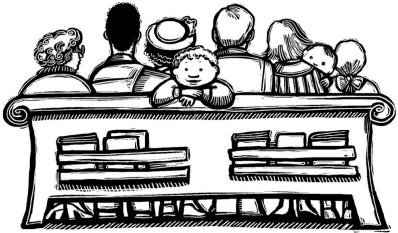


**A** BIG Thanks to all those who so generously purchased gifts for the residents at the Waters. Their
