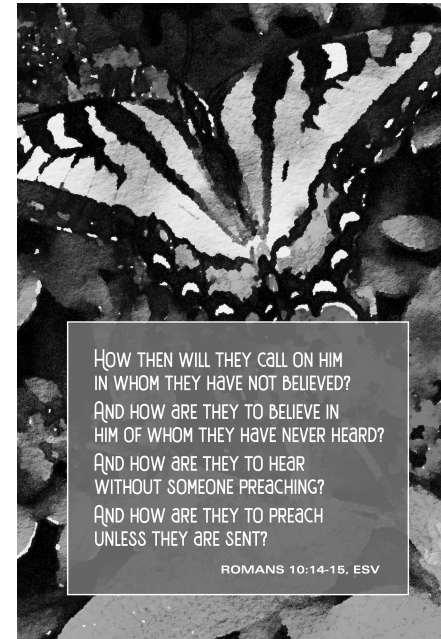

Through it all, Ellie discovers a people, spirit and person who changes the direction of her life.

**Unplanned** based on a true story. (DVD)

Abby Johnson believed in a woman's right to choose. She was the youngest Planned Parenthood Clinic director in the nation. She encouraged women on preventing pregnancy but was involved in referring ladies to more than 22,000 abortions.

One day, she was called into the surgery room to help with a suction procedure and as she watched the baby fight to keep from being suctioned out, she realized how each baby fought back. She resigned and became a spokeswoman for Right to Life and was able to be involved in closing the Planned Parenthood Clinic that she had worked in.
