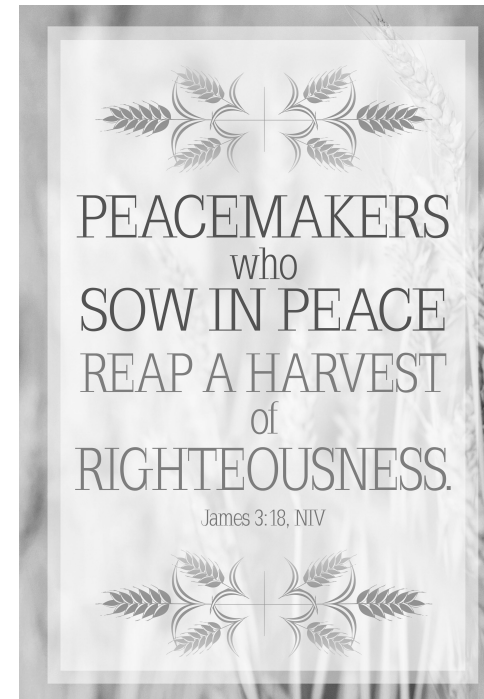

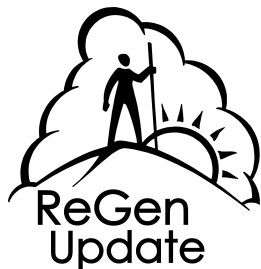

The Youth group will begin meeting in the Fellowship Hall again when school starts. They've enjoyed lots of Summer time antics back at the cabin.

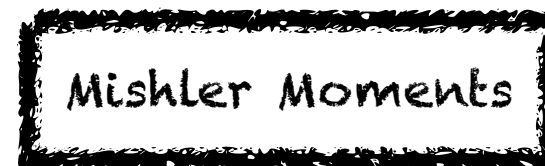
Here are some announcements.
