Mark 1:12-13 (ESV)

¹² The Spirit immediately drove him out into the wilderness. ¹³ And he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him.

2. Give a definition of the word temptation based on the three accounts of Jesus' temptation in the wilderness.
