New bars of bath soap

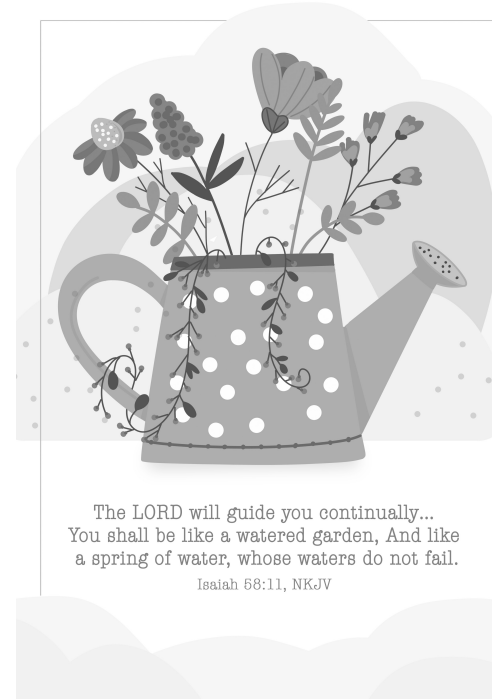
- 85 g (3 oz) or larger

- Homemade laundry soap blocks of (5 oz) or larger are acceptable



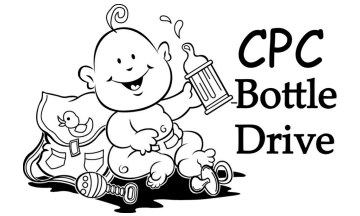

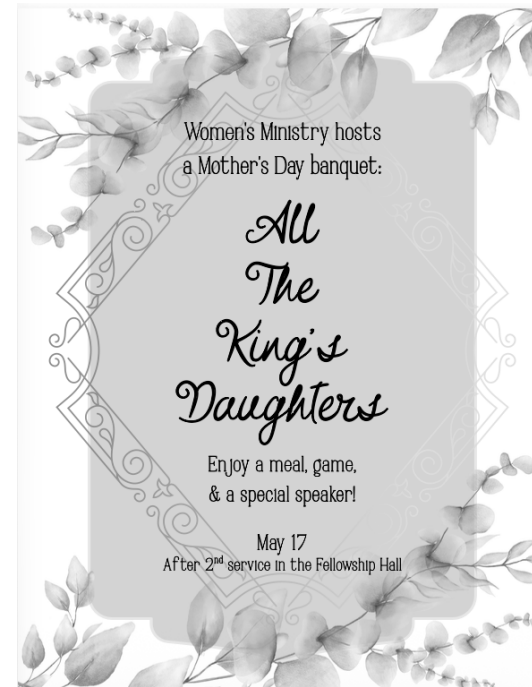

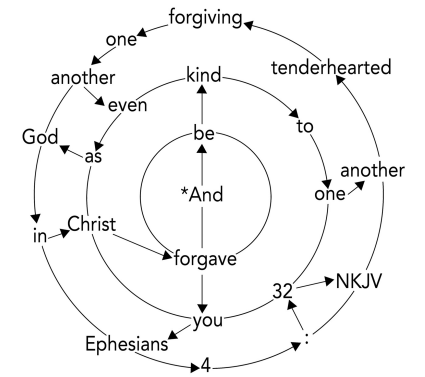
