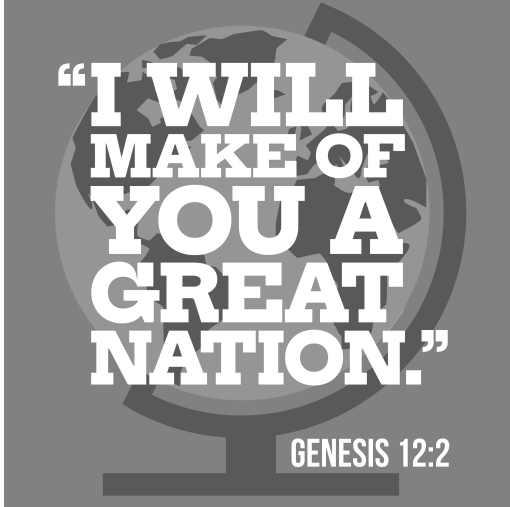

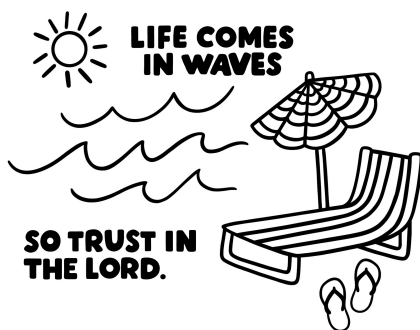

I am the Bible.

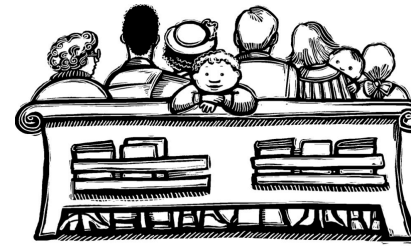

They are anticipating the birth of their daughter in a couple of weeks! They plan to name her Eleanor Joan!

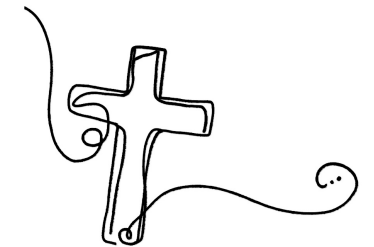
Both of them are employed by KIS Underground, Inc.
